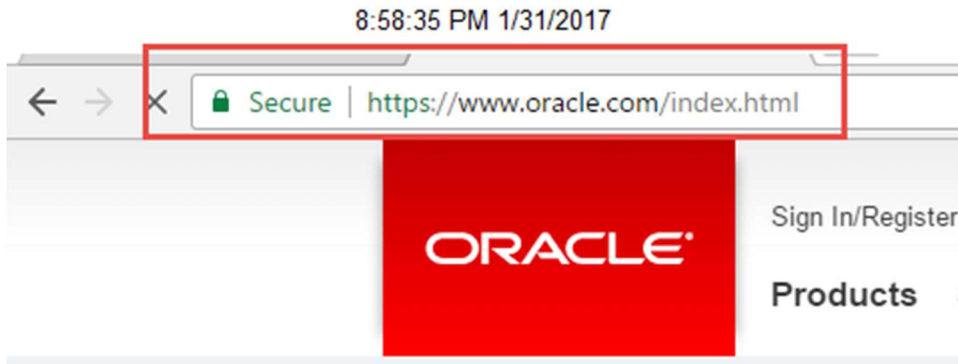
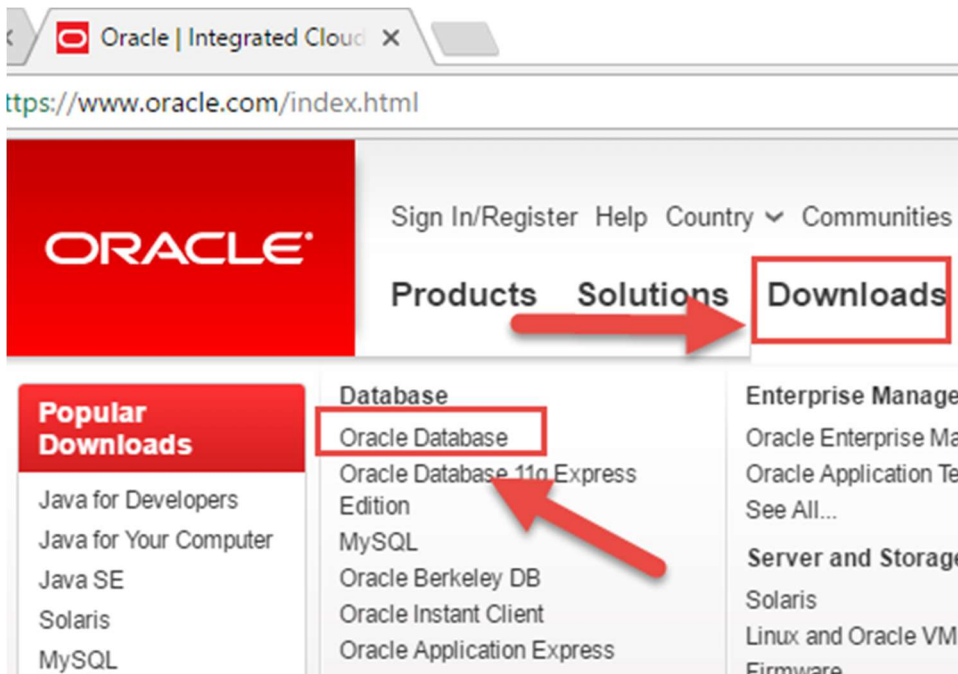


Steps To Install Oracle 11.2.0.1 On Windows

1. Log into to your windows machine as the oracle user (if you have created a new account for the oracle user. You could also use your current user account for the installation. Be sure you have administrative privileges on this account.
2. Go to the oracle website to download the Oracle 11.2.0.1 software. Click [here](#)



3. Follow the link to the **Downloads** page and select the **Oracle Database** link to go the Oracle Database page.



4. Select the Microsoft Windows (x64) version if your windows machine is a 64bit OR Microsoft Windows (32-bit) version if your machine is a 32-bit.

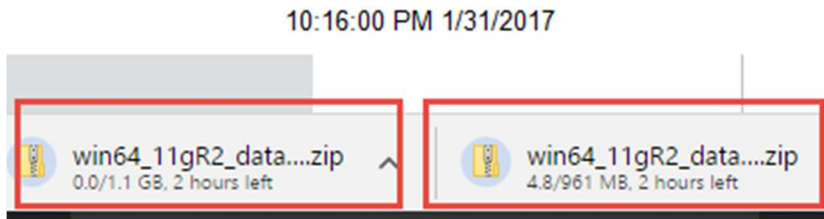

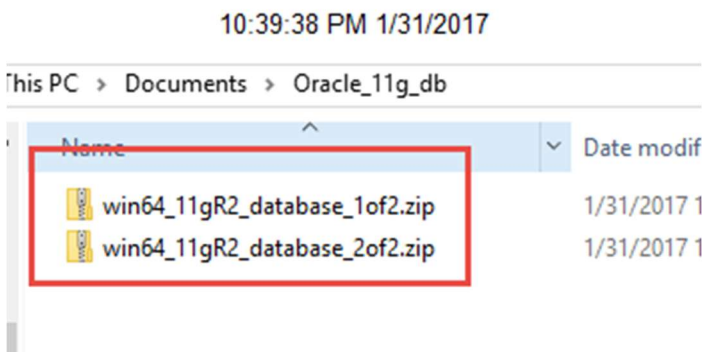

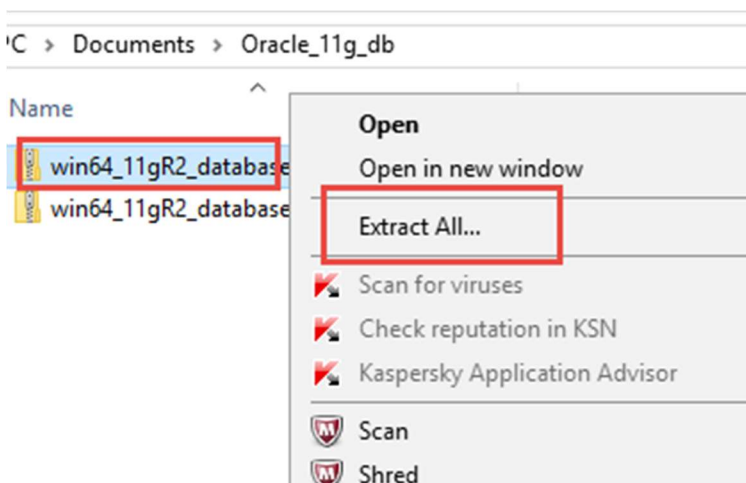
9. The files will get downloaded. The download may take up to an hour because these are large files (greater than 2G). Monitor the download until it completes successfully.



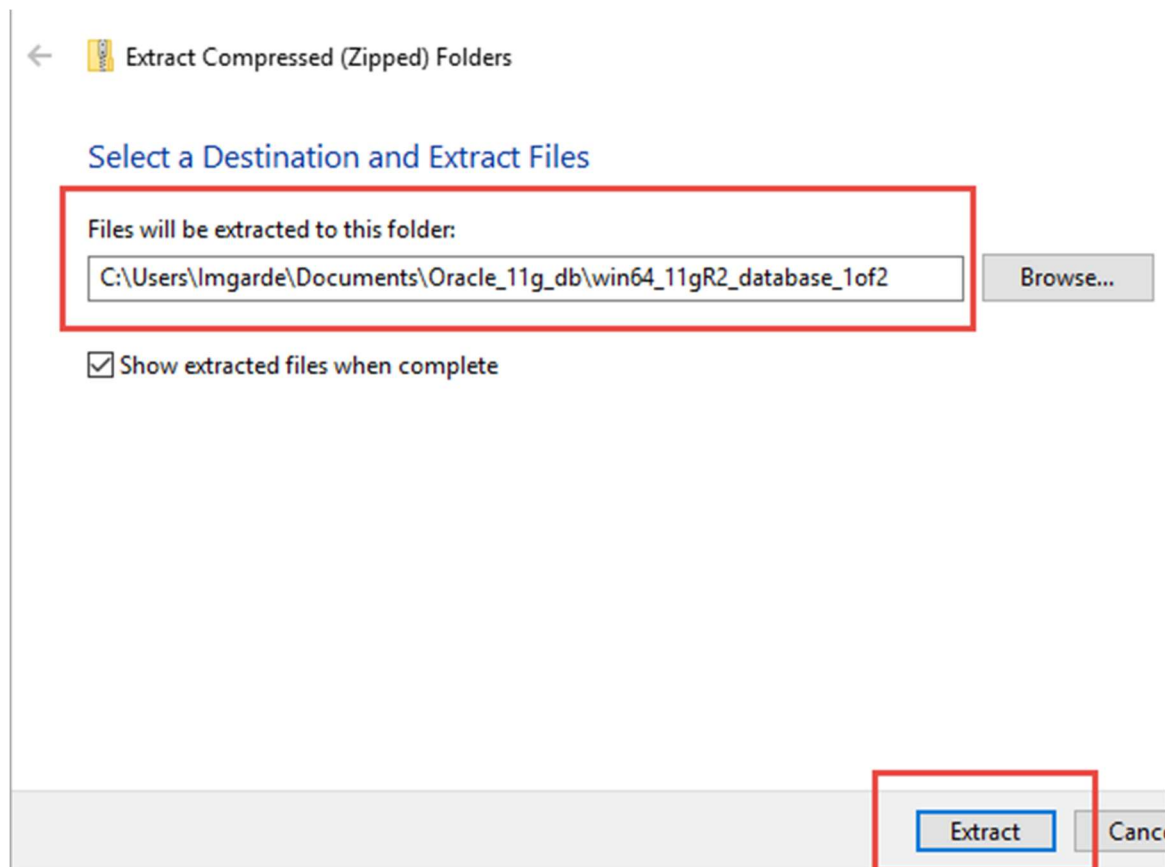
10. When the download completes, there will be two zipped files.



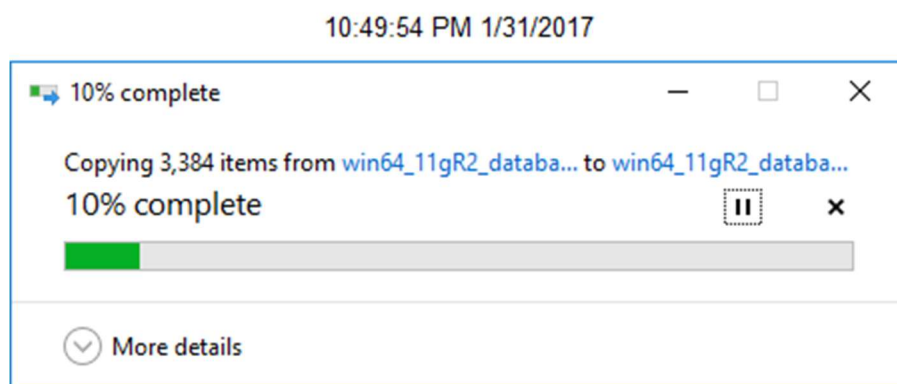
11. To unzip the files, right click on each file and select “**Extract All**”.



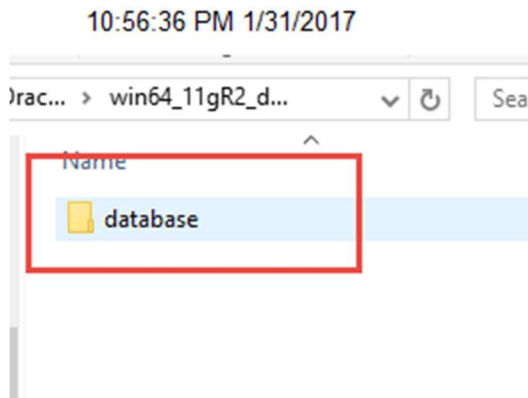
12. Click on browse to select folder that you want to save your files to and click on **Extract**.



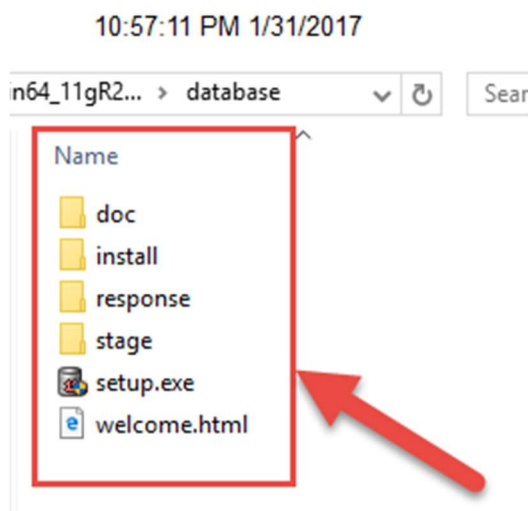
13. The files from win64x_11gR2_database_1of2.zip will be copied to the folder you selected in step 12.



14. Below is a screenshot of the extracted files

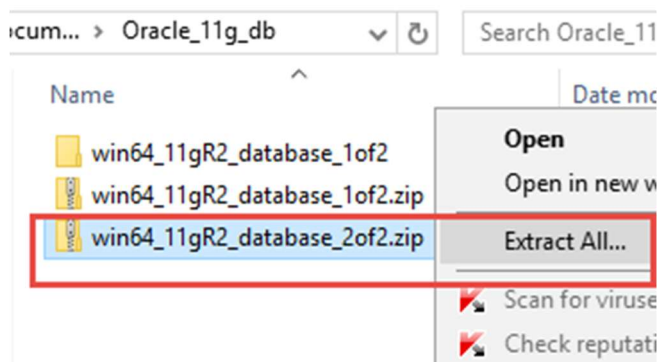


Below are the contents of the folder for **file 1**.

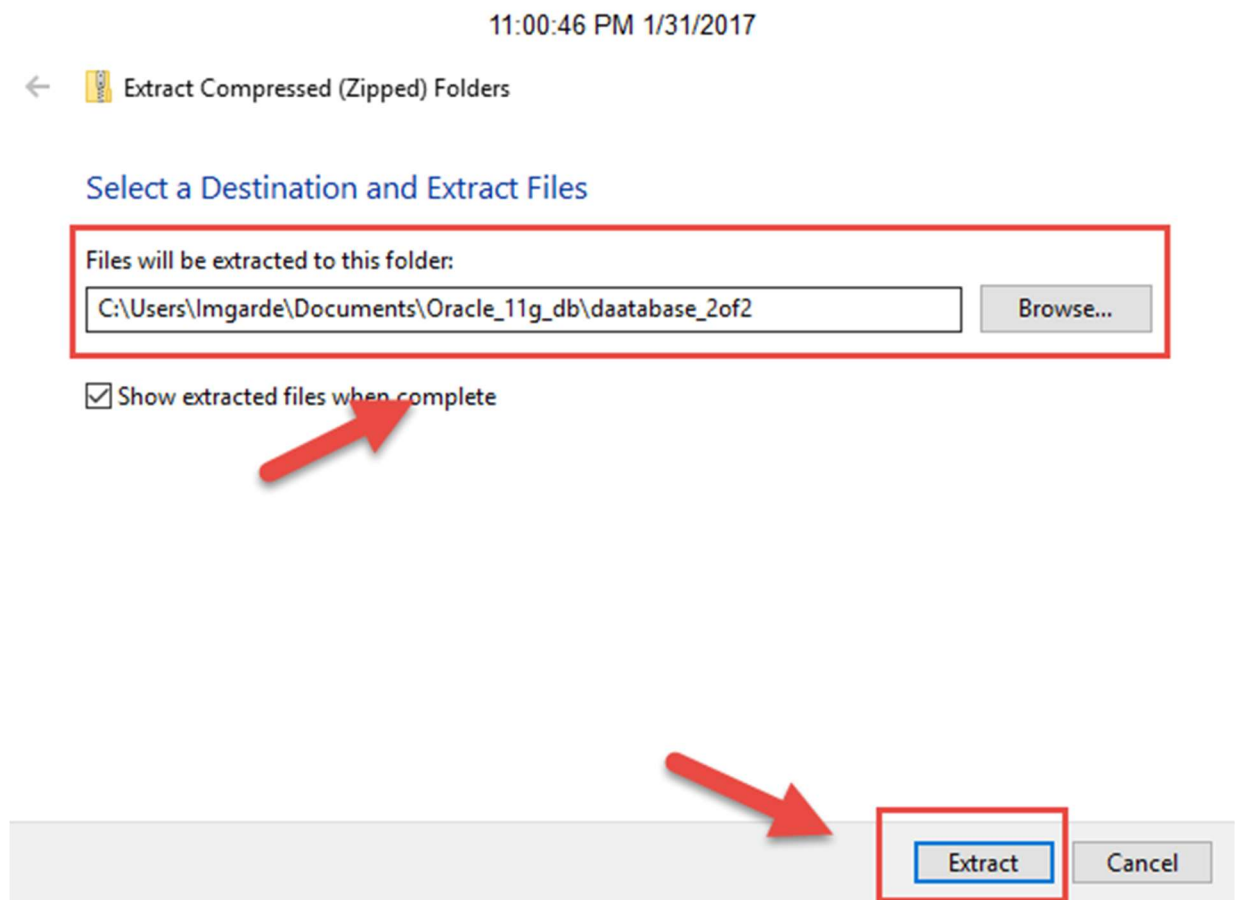


15. Extract the files from **win64x_11gR2_database_2of2.zip** to a separate folder because both files have a folder called Database.

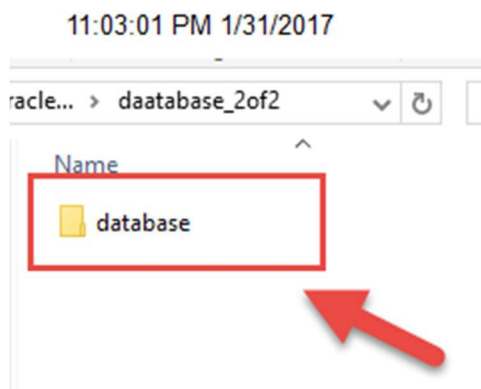

B. Extract files to a separate folder.

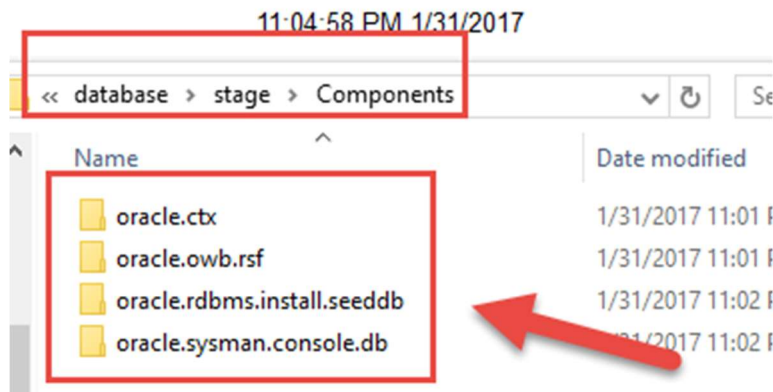


C. Both files have a folder called **Database** as shown below.

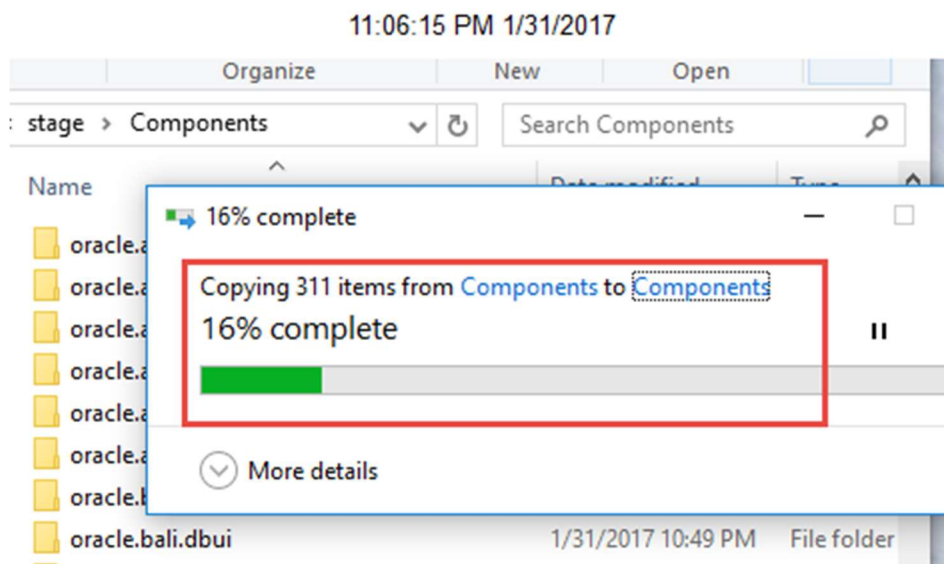


16. We want to merge the contents of file1 with those of file2. To do that copy the contents of file2 (select **database→stage→components**); then copy all the files in the components folder of file 2 to the components folder of file1 located in (**database→stage→components**) as shown below.

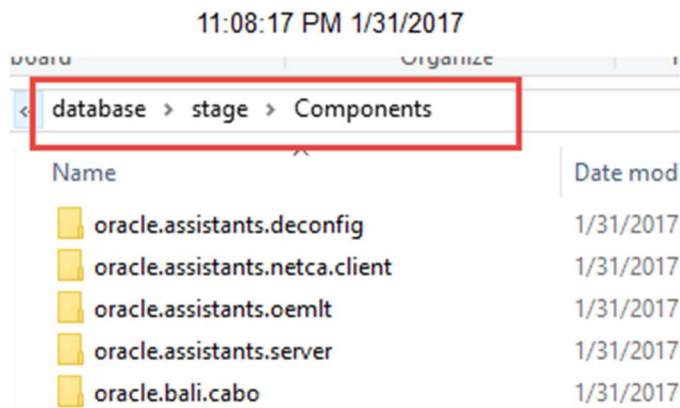
A. Copy all the files under **database→stage→components** folder from the extracted file of win64X_11gR2_database2of.zip



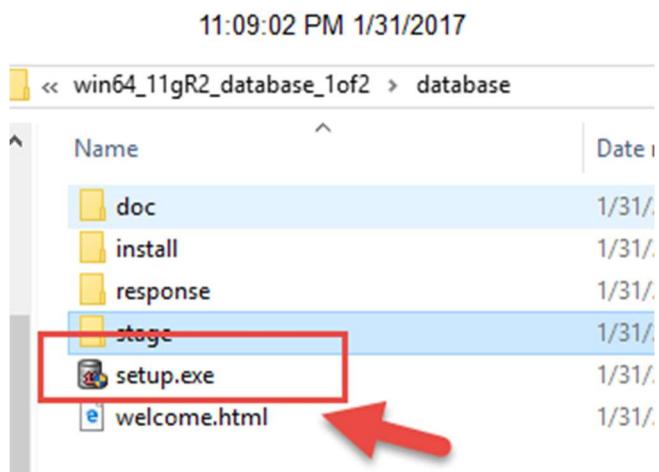
B. Monitor the process to ensure that all the files are successfully copied over.



C. Verify that all the files were copied to components folder of file1 (located under (database →stage→components))

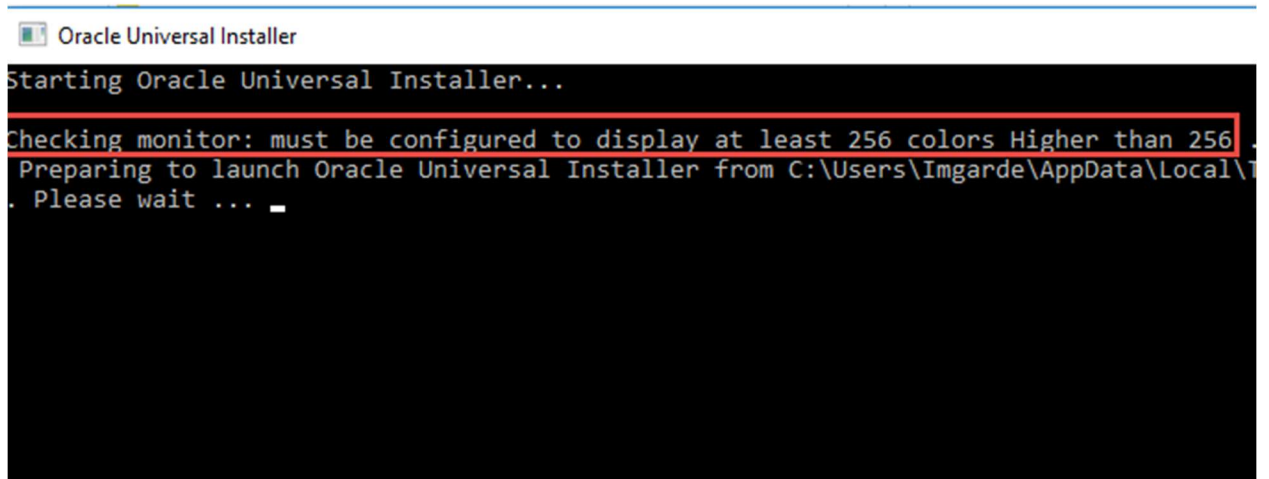


17. Go to the Database folder extracted from file 1 and double click on a file called **setup.exe** to launch the **runInstaller** tool which will be used to install the oracle database software.



18. The installer will check if your monitor can display at least 256 colors before it launches.

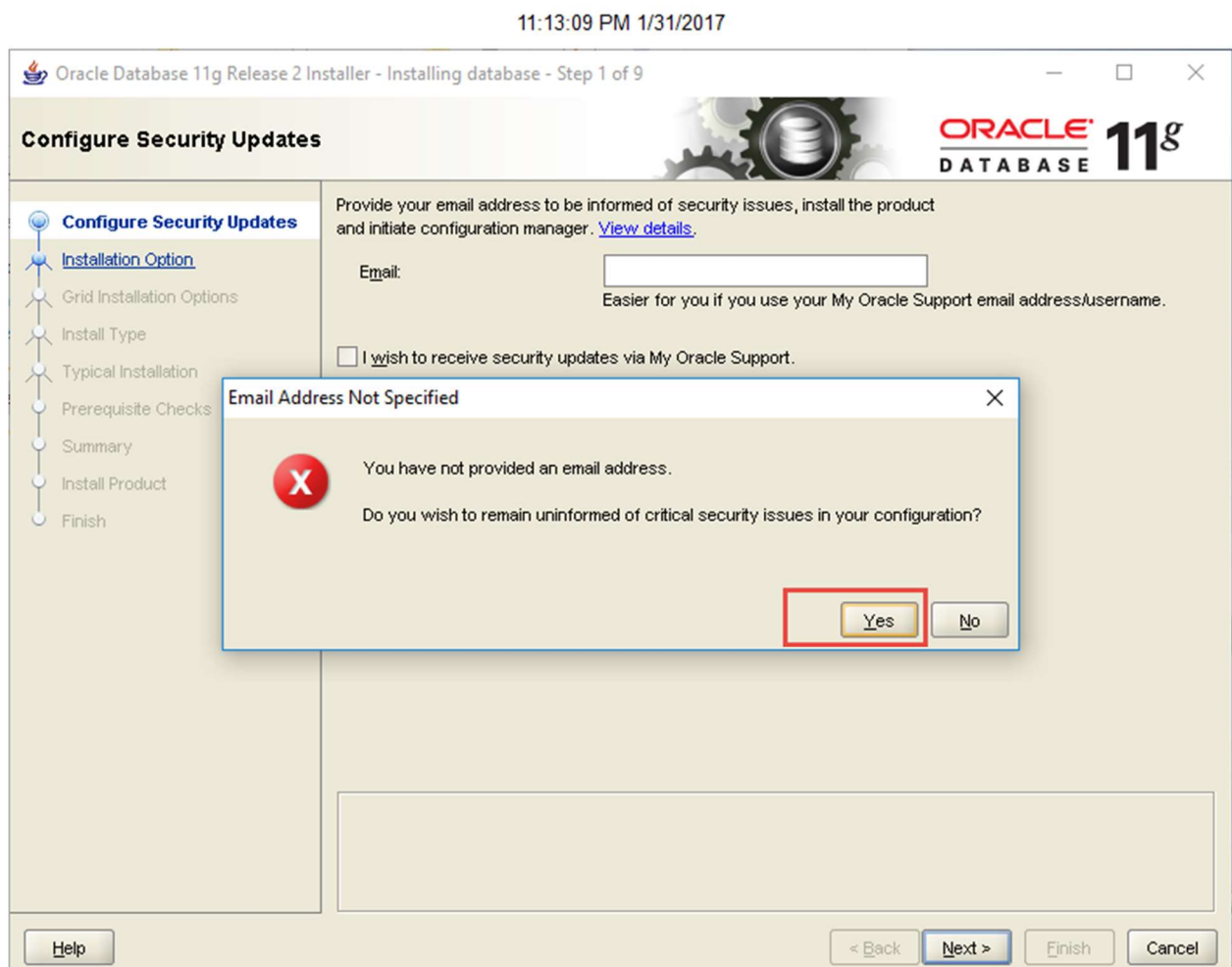

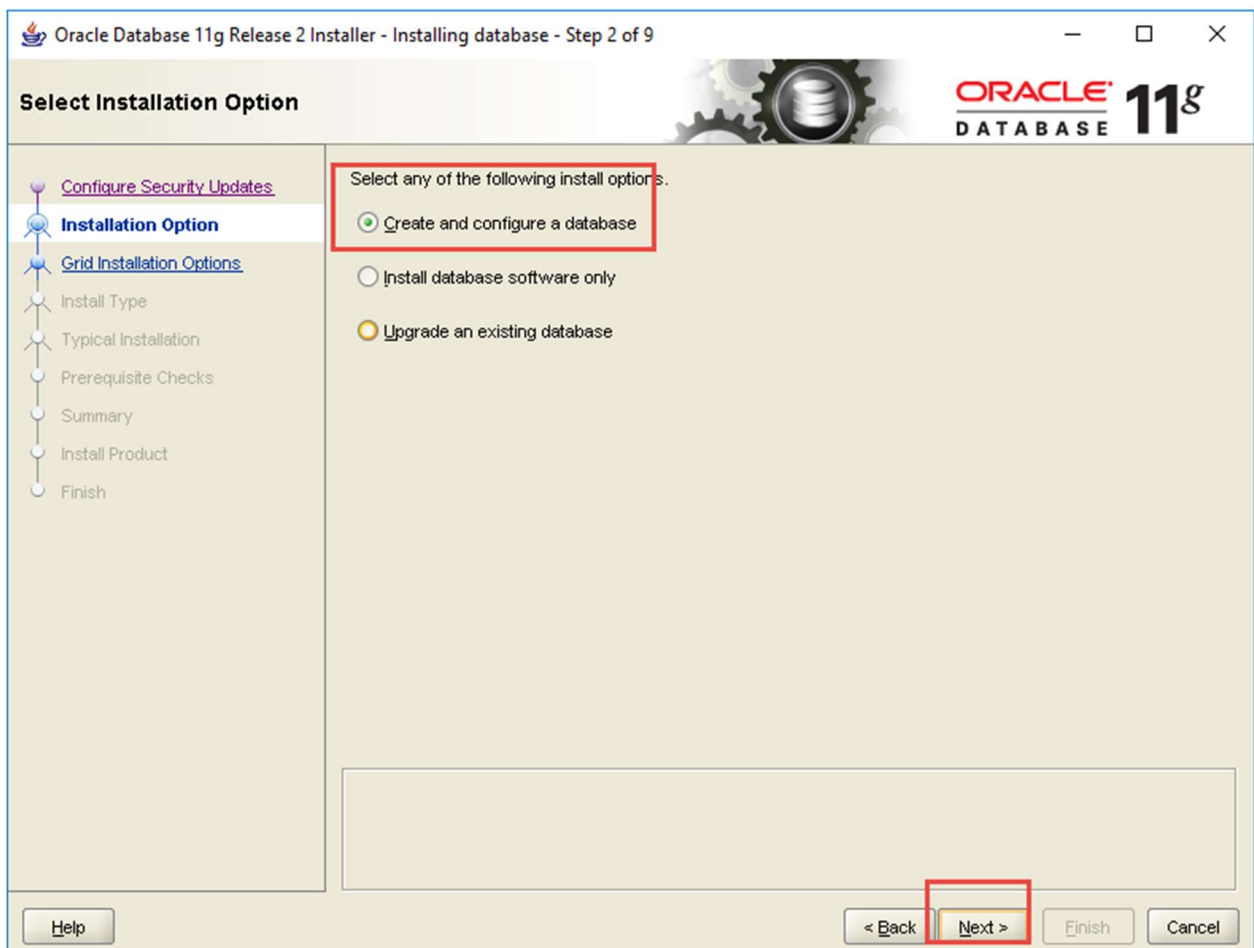

20. Click on **yes** and select **Next** to go to the next step on the screen.

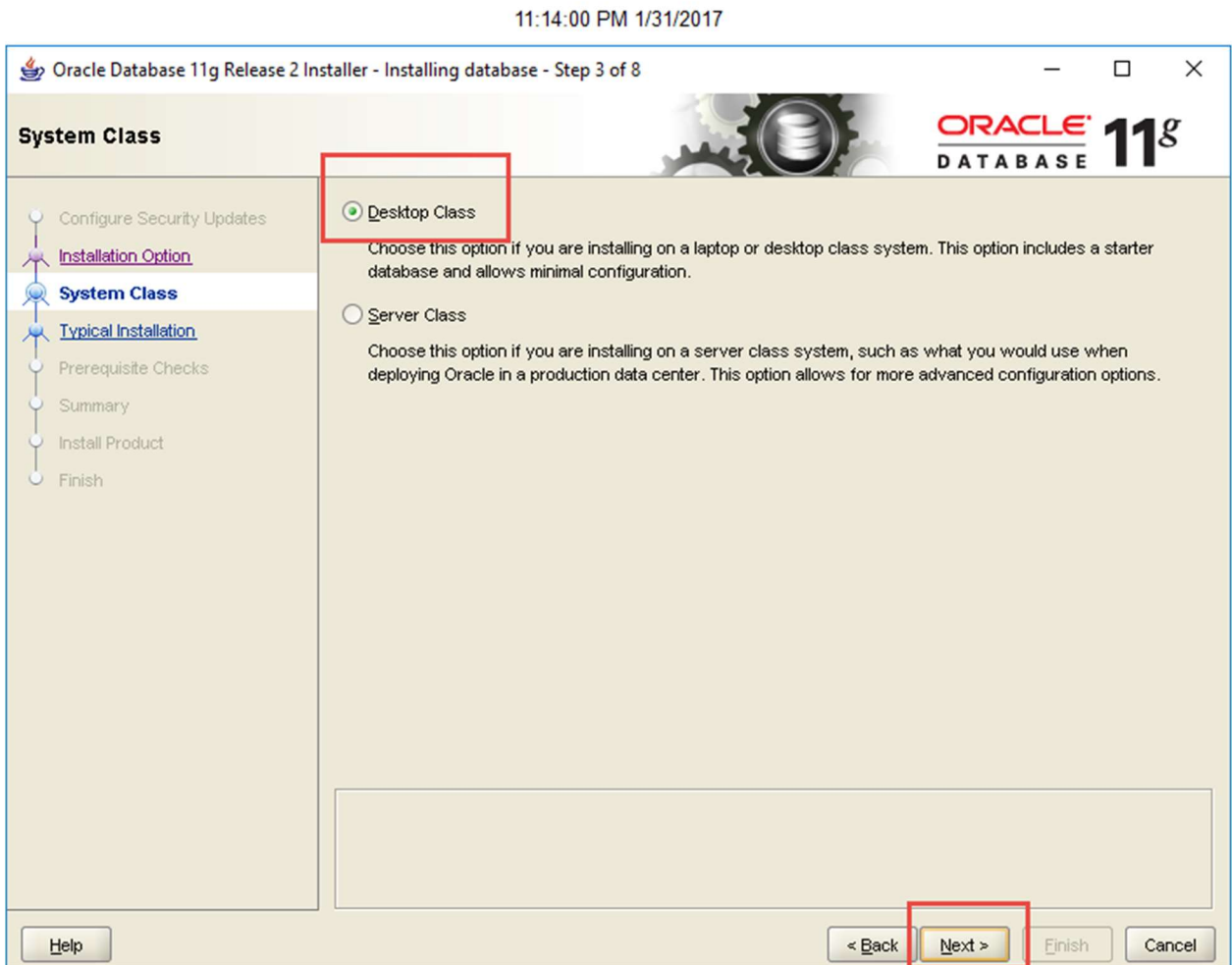


21. Select the option to **create and configure database** and select **Next** at the bottom of screen to go next step.

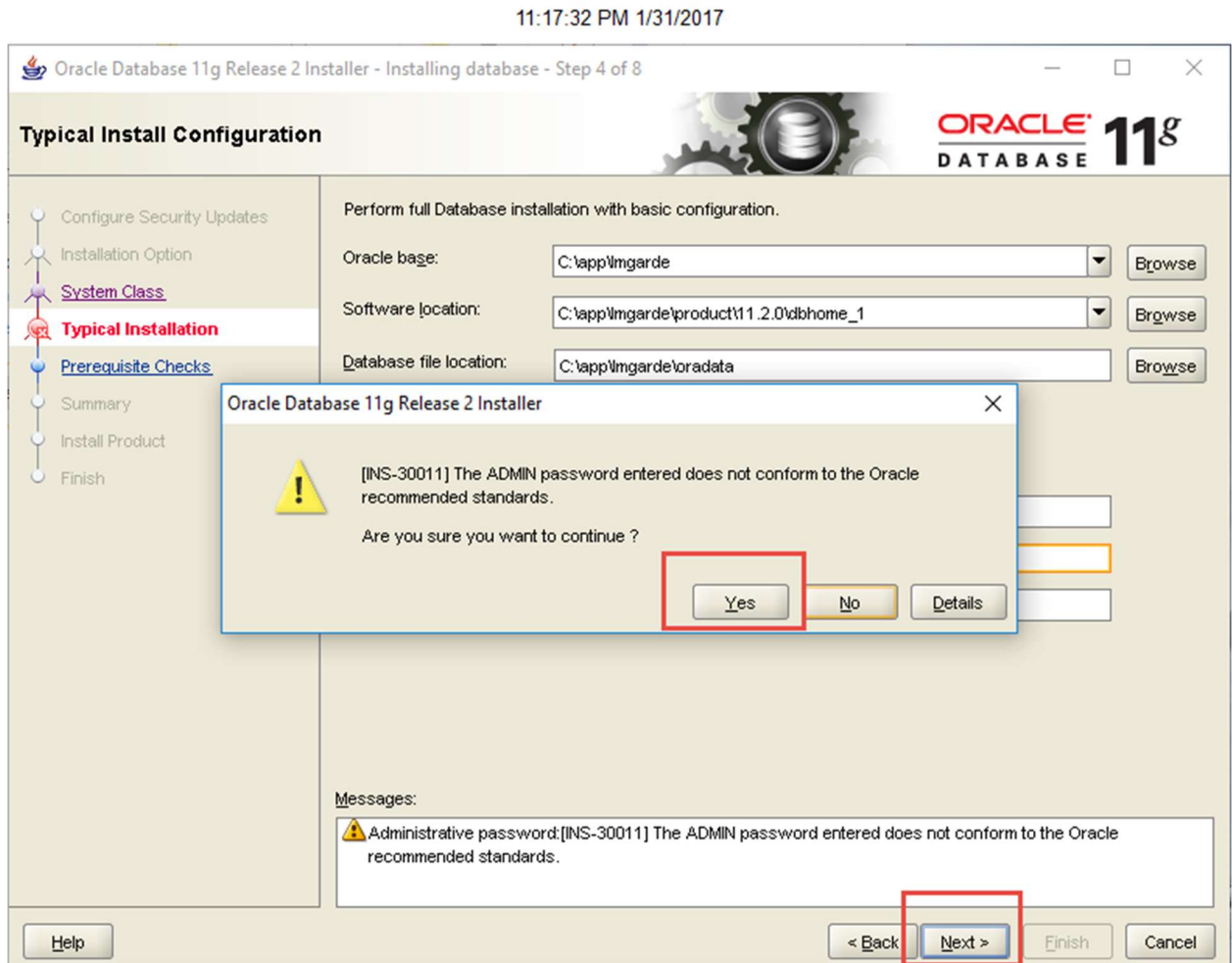

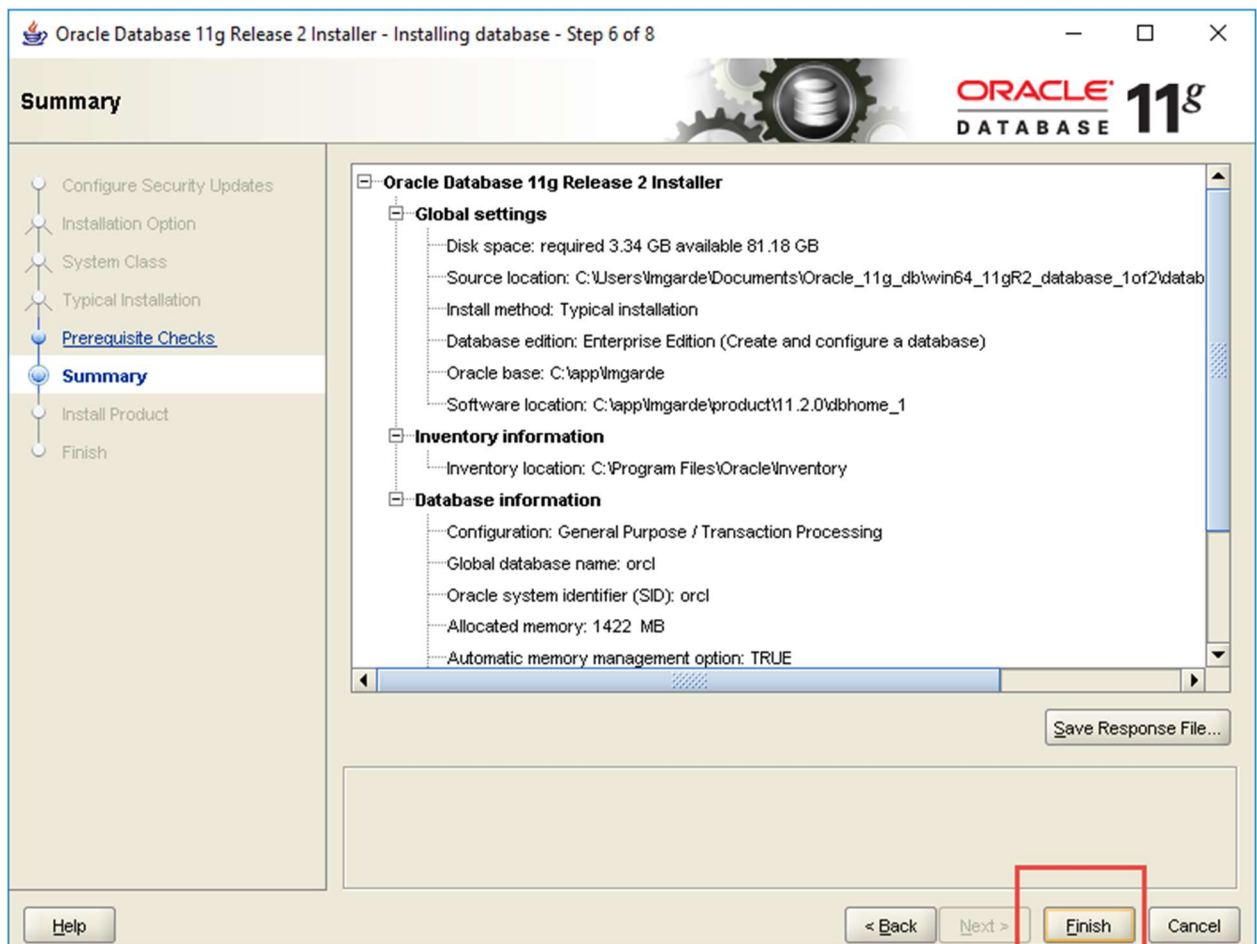

24. Select **Yes** and click **Next** to proceed.

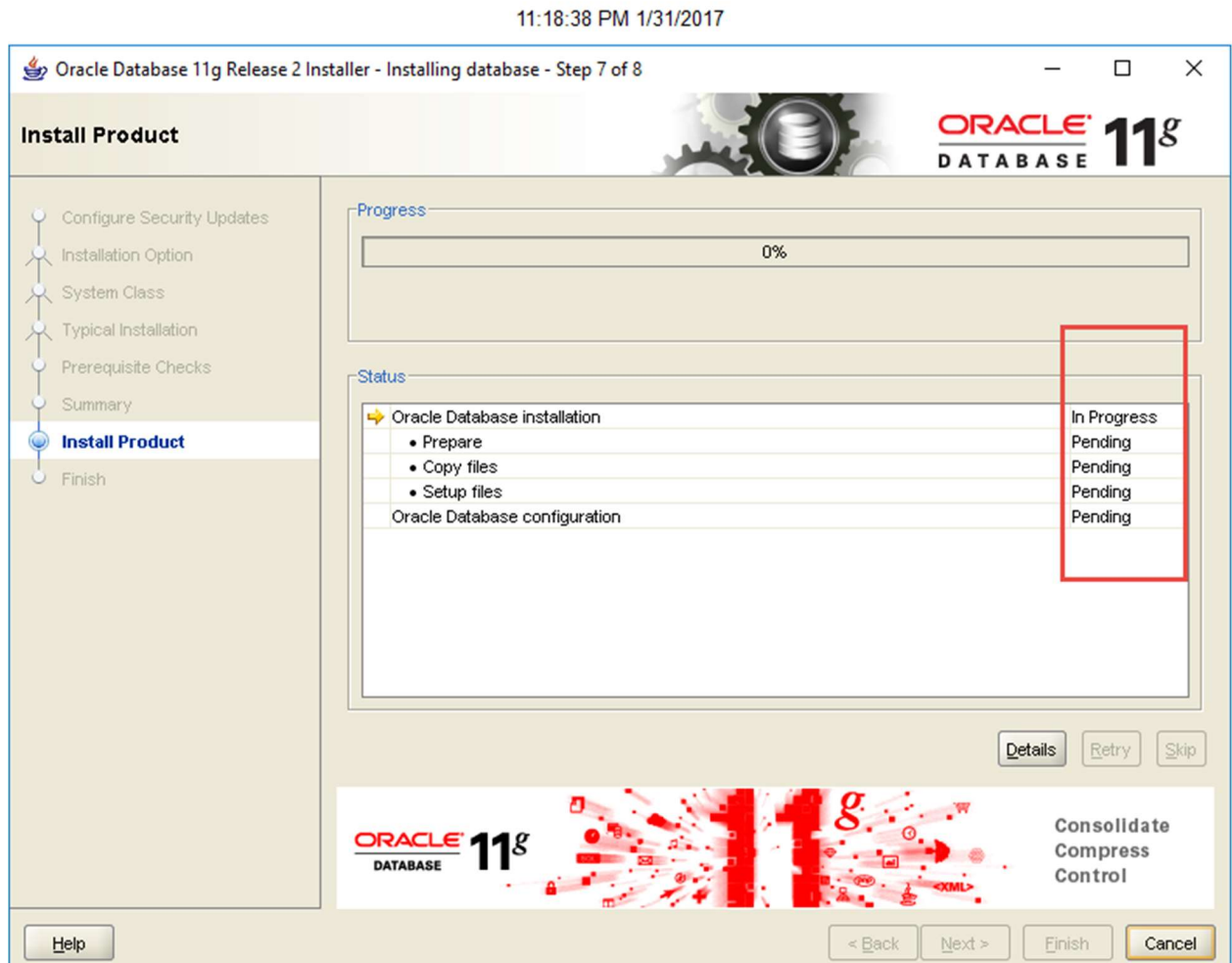

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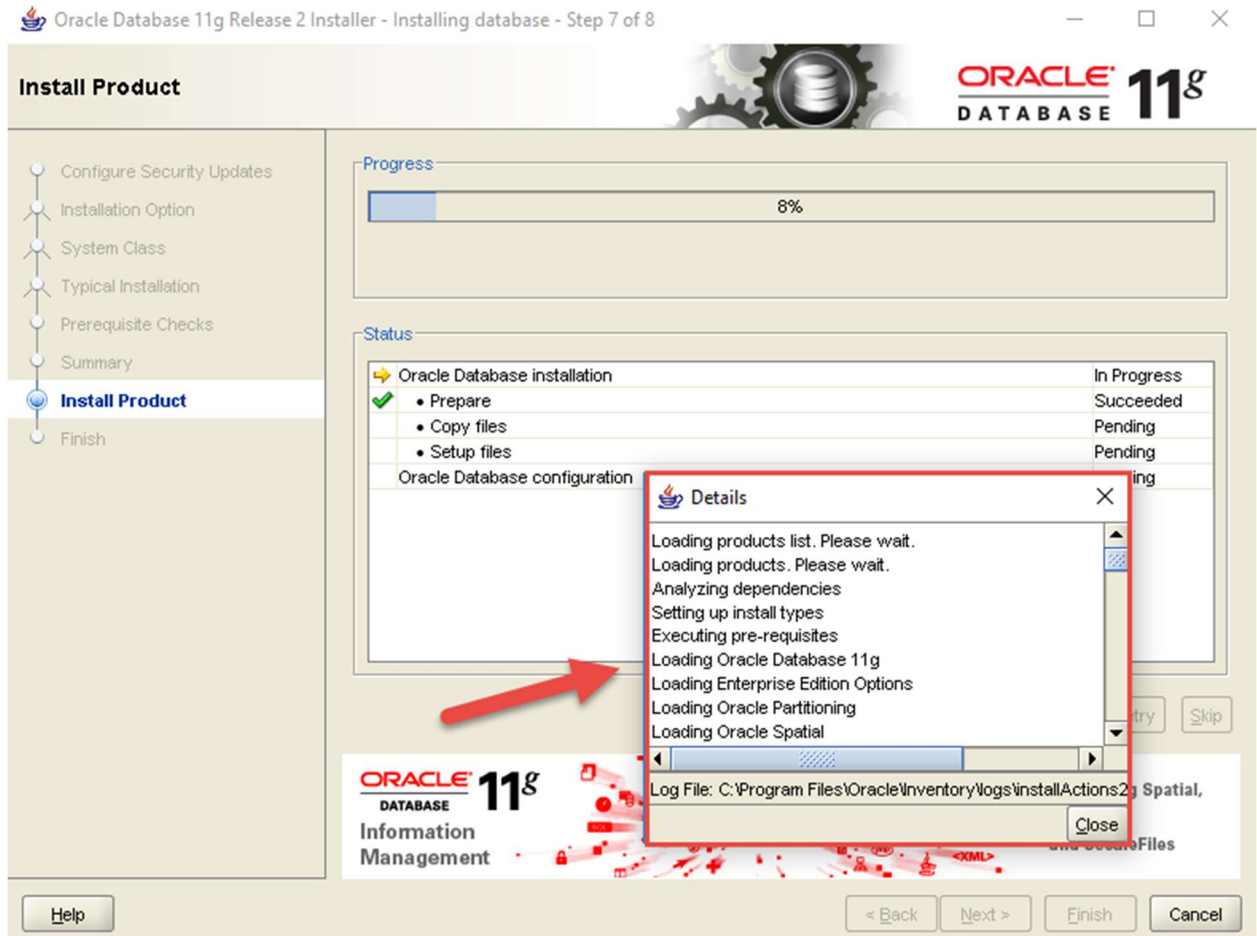


26. Oracle software is getting installed.

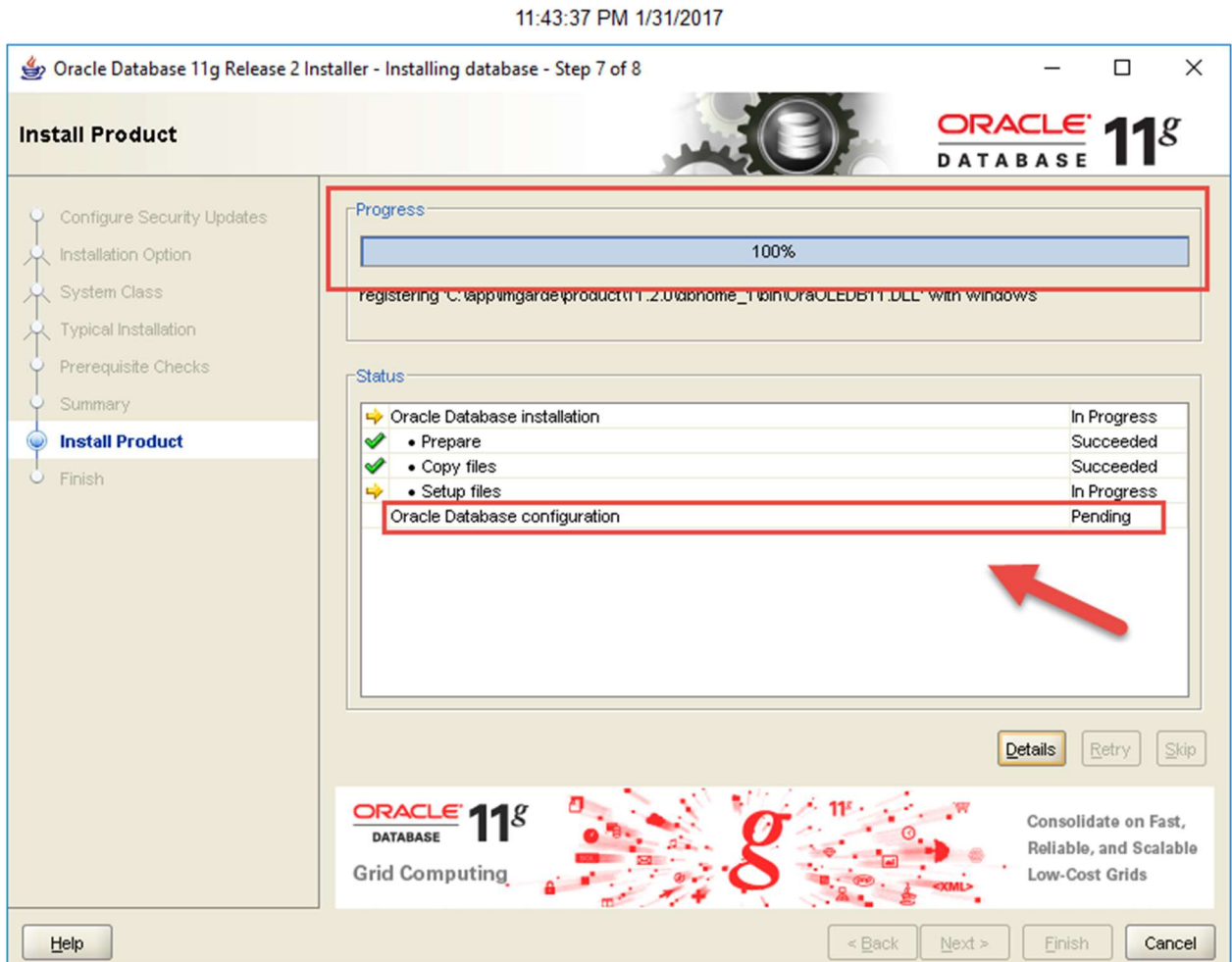


27. Monitor the installation until it completes successfully.

A. Monitor installation until it completes.

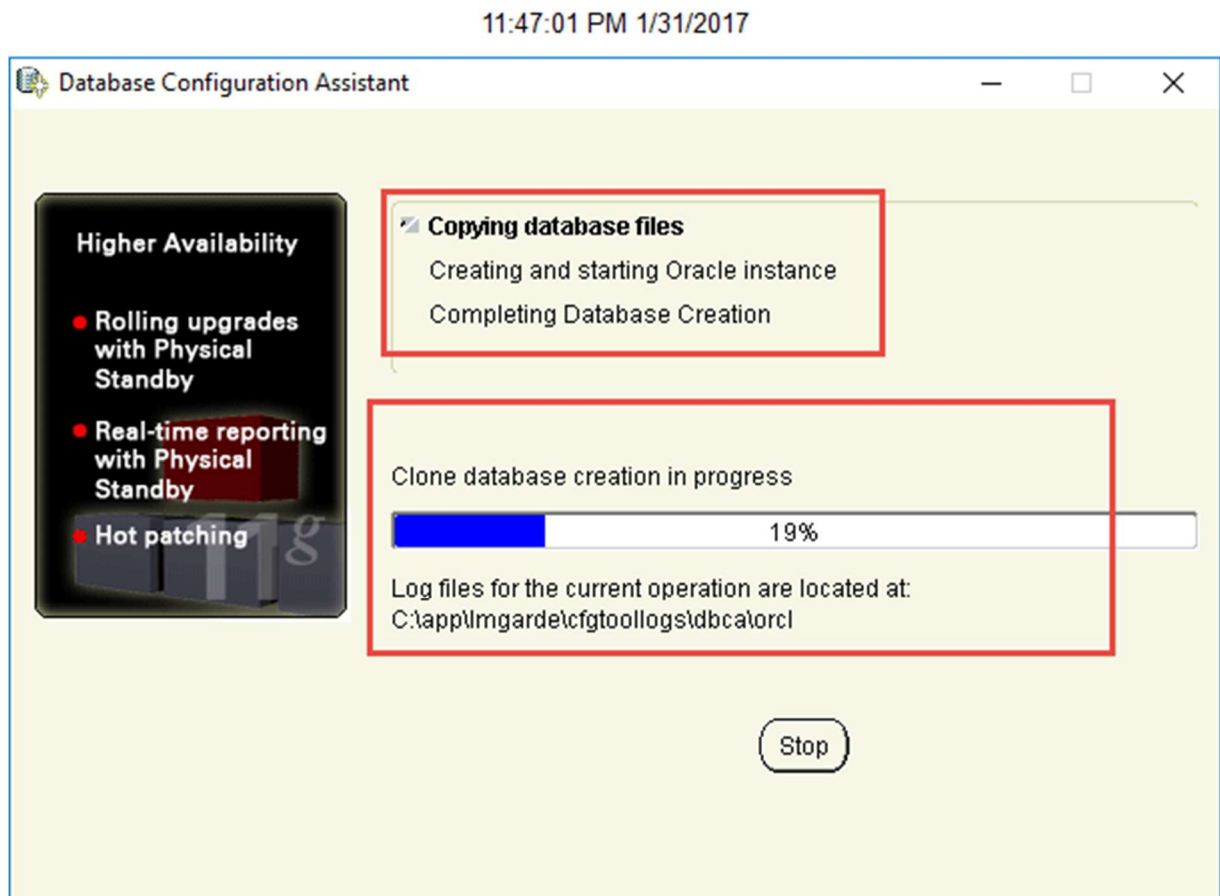


B. Installation of the oracle database software has completed.

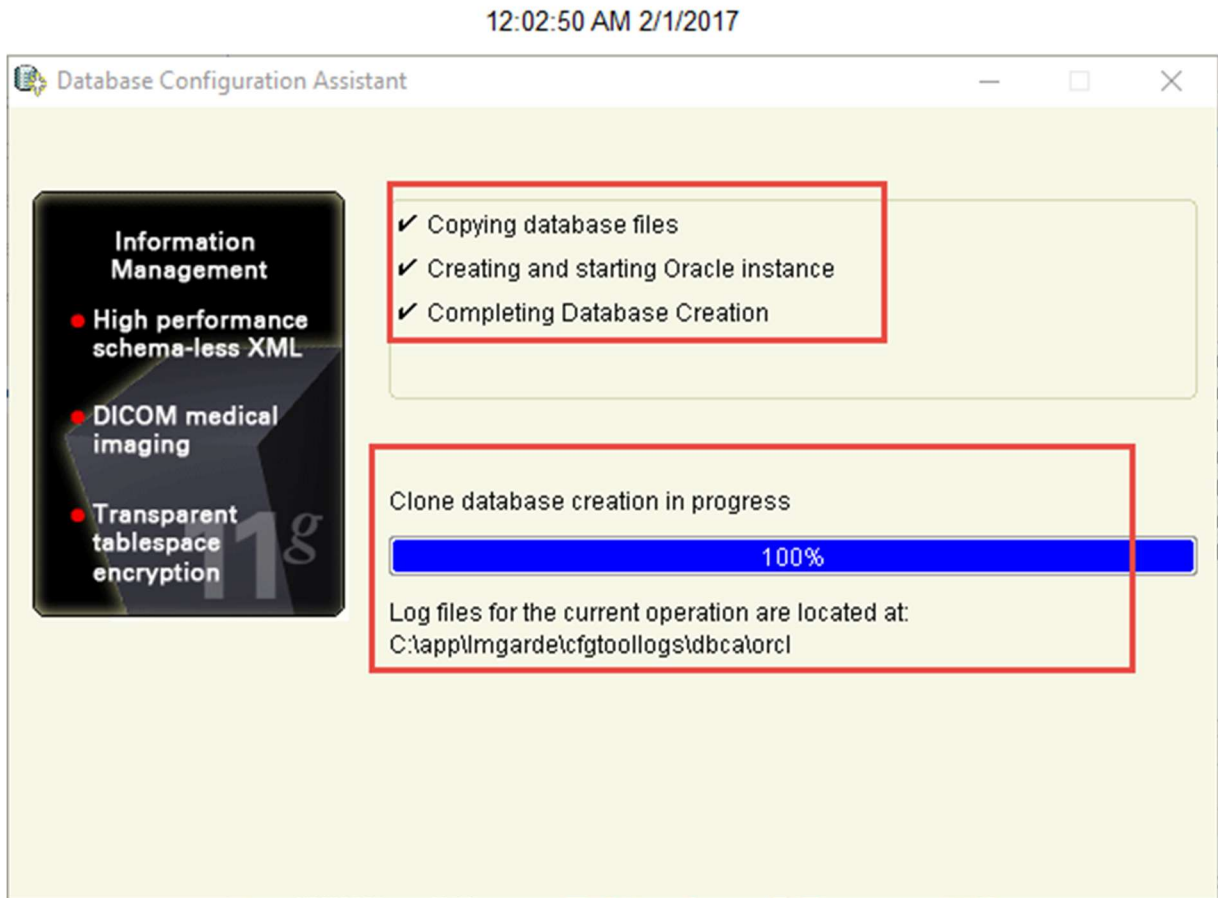


28. Once, the oracle database software successfully installs, the Database Configuration Assistant tool will be launched automatically to create the database. Monitor the database creation process until it completes successfully.

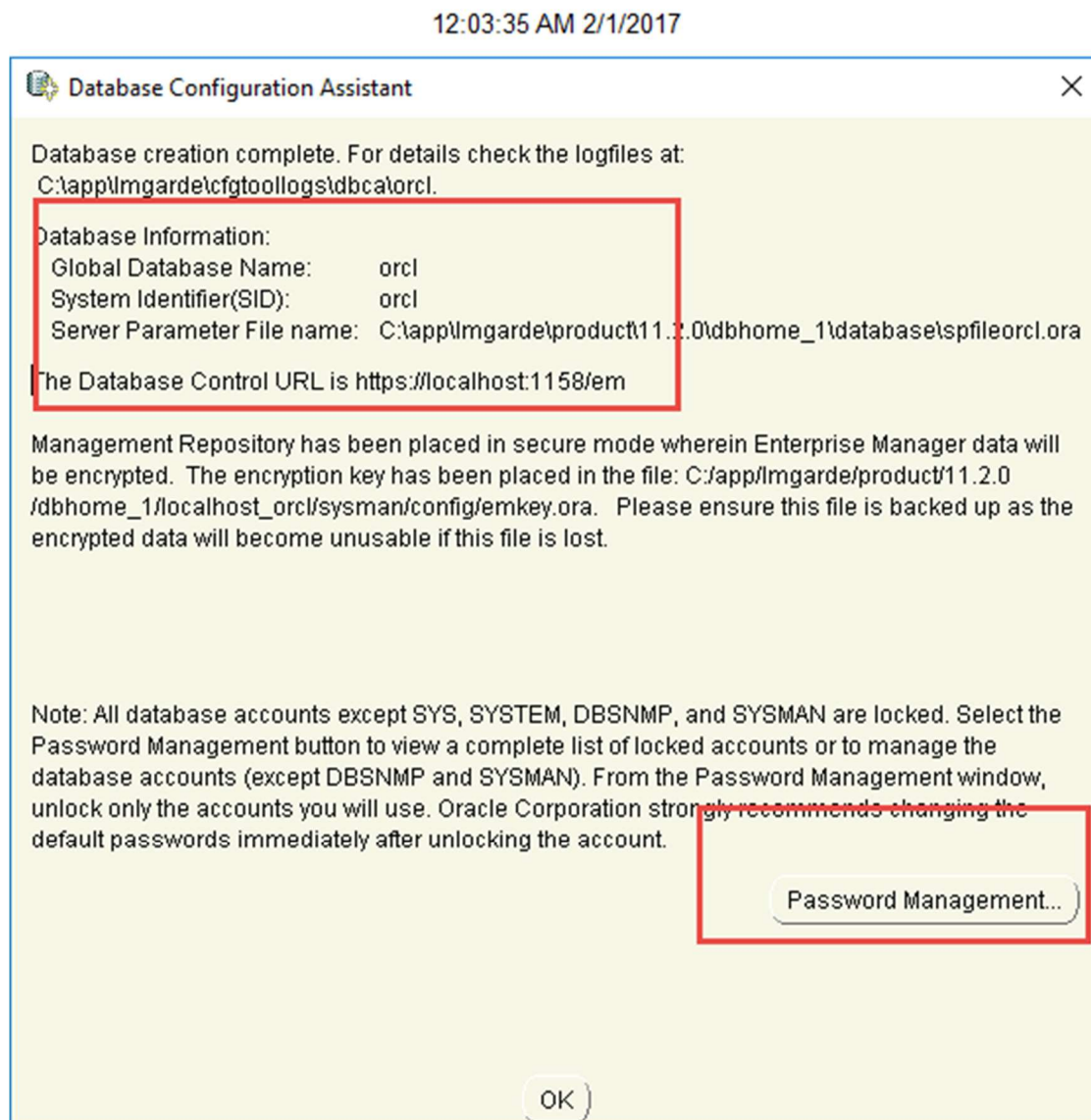
A. Monitor database creation process until it completes successfully.



B. The database was successfully created.

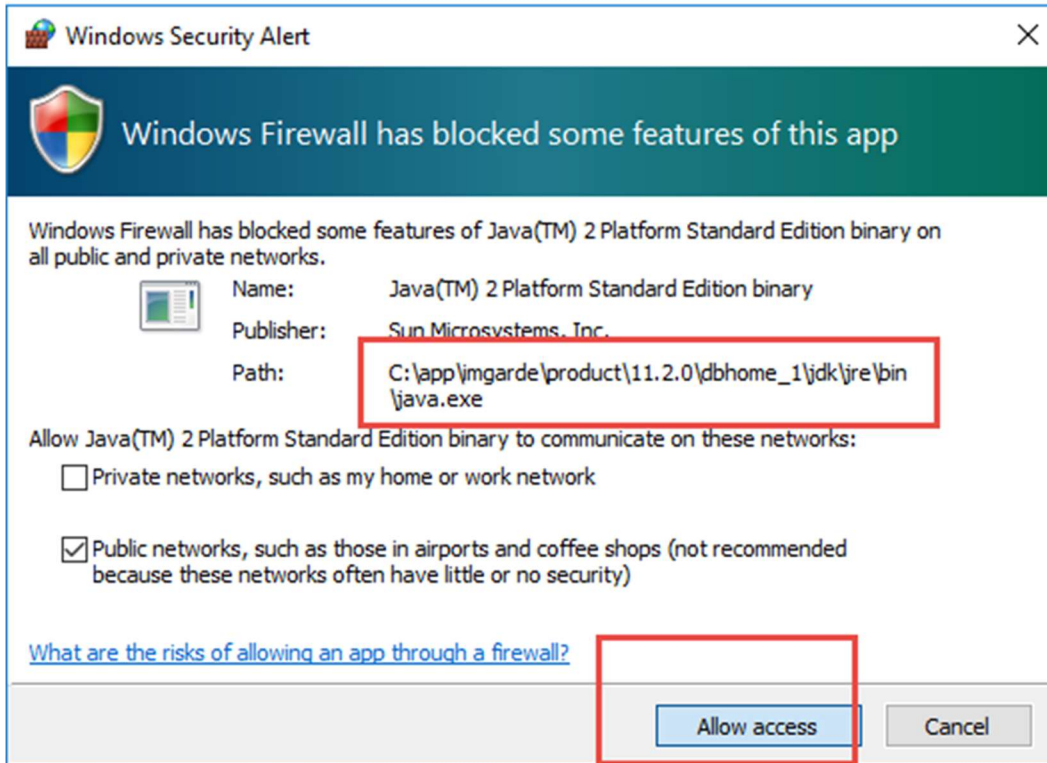


29. Database has been successfully created. Note the database information on screen

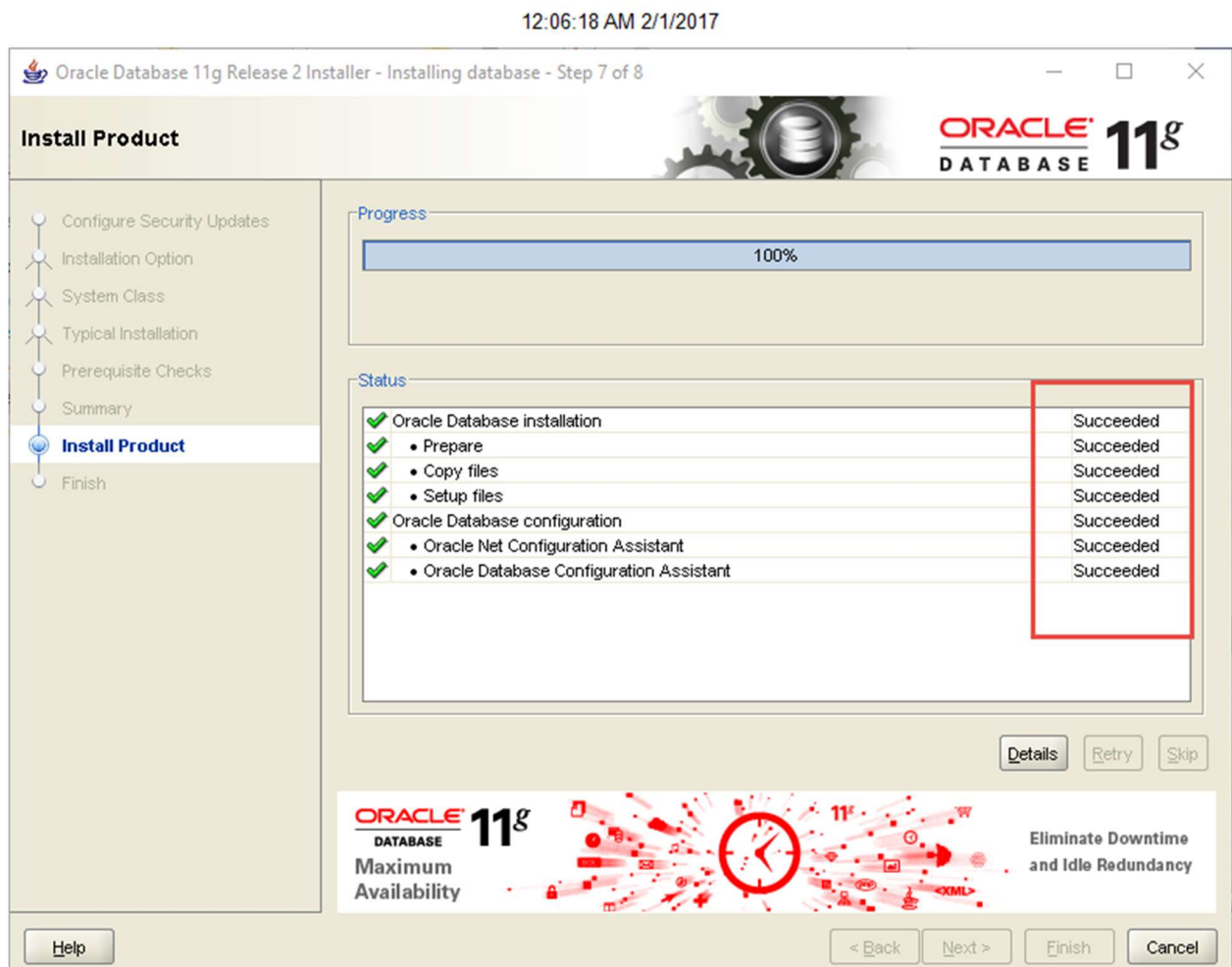
